Over 130 donations were received during the first four years, resulting in \$25,000 in donations and enabling 97 awards to be given. Award ceremonies were held in 2017, 2018, and 2019 attended by awardees, their families, donors, elected and school officials. Awards tripled from 2017 to 2018, doubled from 2018 to 2019 and expected to show a continued growth to 100 awards in 2020.
